- A strong B2 speaker can:**
- Speak fluently enough to maintain a conversation without frequent pauses.
  - Express opinions, explain ideas, and give reasons for them.
  - Discuss familiar and moderately complex topics in some detail.
  - Use a reasonably wide range of vocabulary, including some less common expressions.
  - Use a variety of grammatical structures, although errors still occur.
  - Paraphrase when they do not know a particular word.
  - Follow natural conversation and respond appropriately without needing everything repeated.
  - Tell stories, describe experiences, and explain problems clearly.
  - Adapt their language to different situations, although they may still sound less natural in formal or unfamiliar contexts.
  - Handle spontaneous conversation rather than relying heavily on prepared language.

combining and completing these  
2 programmes (Vocab +  
Grammar) will give you a solid  
foundation for both C1 and C2  
exam prep courses.

we use the flipped classroom method:  
**FIRST** - you watch videos / read and  
complete the E-books and do the online  
interactive activities.  
**THEN** - you pick one (or both) of the  
workshop dates during the week and  
practise. we only speak during  
workshops(!), have role-plays, watch  
videos and engage in real-life  
conversations. the focus is always what  
you have learnt for that workshop.  
I will create a context in which you will  
naturally use and practise the newly  
learnt phrases and structures.

for each workshop, you will find  
dozens of interactive activities  
related to a particular topic.  
after completing the tasks and  
the E-book, it will be very easy  
to use those phrases in the  
small-group discussions. you will  
always prepare with a short 1-2  
minute presentation for each  
workshop on the given topic, but  
no other 'homework' will be  
checked.

  - Use a broad range of vocabulary, including precise, idiomatic, and less common expressions.
  - Choose words and expressions accurately to convey subtle differences in meaning.
  - Use a wide range of grammatical structures flexibly and naturally, with only occasional errors.
  - Adapt their language effectively to different situations, levels of formality, and conversational partners.
  - Connect ideas naturally and use discourse markers effectively to make their speech clear and well organised.
